## Attention LWSRA Residents

**Northern Will County Special Recreation Association (NWCSRA) and Lincolnway Special Recreation Association (LWSRA) have an agreement that offers programs to the other Association's residents at the resident rates, with the following exceptions:**

1. Special Services such as scholarships, door-to-door transportation and first-time participant discounts are not included.
2. Adult Day Program, Day camps, vacation trips, away camps and weekend (overnight) trips are excluded but individuals may still register at non-resident rates.
3. Early bird or other discounts do not apply under this agreement. Registration priority may be given to the home association's residents first.
4. When programs are offered free to either association's own residents, the program or event will be offered to residents of the other association at the regular fee for residents.
5. If both agencies offer the same or similar program, non-residents may register at the non-resident price.

LWSRA residents are taxpayers of Crete Park District, Frankfort Park District, Frankfort Square Park District, Manhattan Park District, Mokena Community Park District, New Lenox Community Park District, Peotone Park District, and Wilmington Park District.

## Transportation

For programs with transportation, the following are the drop off and pick up locations. Look for this bus icon to indicate the option for transportation.

Transportation times and locations will be determined based on enrollment at the time of the registration deadline.

**A minimum is required at any site in order to offer transportation.** Staff will send transportation information to all those registered prior to the start of the program.

## Program Guidelines

- Northern Will County Special Recreation Association provides sufficient staff to participant ratio to ensure a safe and meaningful recreation experience.
- When arriving and departing a program, parents/guardians are required to “check in” with a program staff.
- Participants will only be released to designated individuals approved by parents/guardians. Any changes to a participant's approved list must be updated in your online account.
- Participants will not be released to depart from or wait unattended after any program without a signed waiver.
- NWCSRA staff will not be responsible for participants arriving prior to the scheduled program time.
- NWCSRA reserves the right to cancel a program or event due to insufficient enrollment.

## Behavior Expectations

Northern Will County Special Recreation Association encourages and promotes the concept of fun for everyone. Certain rules and guidelines have been established to ensure the safety and enjoyment for everyone. Participants, staff, volunteers and parents/guardians are expected to exhibit appropriate behavior at all times. Additional rules may be developed for particular programs and athletic leagues as deemed necessary by staff. All parties shall:

- Show respect to all participants, staff, volunteers and parents.
- Abstain from using abusive or foul language.
- Refrain from causing bodily harm to others.
- Demonstrate respect to equipment, supplies, uniforms and facilities.
- Represent NWCSRA in a manner that is consistent with the goals, objectives and ethics of the association.

Individual behavior plans may be developed on the advice of parents/guardians, staff members or other professionals. NWCSRA reserves the right to pause participation or dismiss any individual if the above procedures are not adhered to. Each situation will be evaluated individually and on its own merit.

## Board of Directors Meetings

The public is invited to attend Northern Will County Special Recreation Association Board of Directors meetings. Meetings are held the fourth Wednesday of each month, unless otherwise posted, at 1:30 pm at the office: 10 Montrose Drive, Romeoville. You may call NWCSRA at (815) 407-1819 if you would like more information regarding these meetings.

## Participant Illness Guidelines

To prevent the spread of contagious illnesses, participants should not attend programs when any of the following symptoms exist:

- Fever of 100° or higher
- Vomiting or diarrhea within the last 24 hours
- Contagious rash or a rash of unknown origin
- Persistent cough and/or cold symptoms
- “Pink eye” (conjunctivitis) or discharge from the eye
- Symptoms of mumps, measles, chicken pox, strep throat, flu, impetigo, coxsackie virus, head lice, mites and ringworm, or coronavirus

- Runny nose with yellow or green discharge

Please notify the NWCSRA office if the participant contracts any contagious illness that will affect his/her attendance at the program. Participants should return to programs at the recommendation of their doctor, or, if not under a doctor's care, when the symptoms have clearly passed.

## Program Cancellations Due To Weather

Cancellation of a program or transportation is possible if conditions are considered unsafe.

- Three hours prior to the starting time of the program or transportation route, NWCSRA will determine if the program should be cancelled due to weather. You will be contacted ONLY if the program is cancelled. The program may or may not be rescheduled.

## Late Pick-Up

Participants must be picked up at the designated time that is listed in the program guide, flyer or verbally informed by the staff. considered unsafe.

- There will be a \$20 fee for parents/guardians who are 15 minutes late to pick up their son/daughter from a program. An additional \$20 will be charged for every hour past the ending time of the program.
- Payment is due at the time of pick up or prior to the next program that the participant is registered for. If payment is not received, then the participant will not be allowed to attend the next program until the late fee is paid.

## Personal Items

NWCSRA discourages bringing unnecessary personal items to programs. Staff are not responsible for lost, damaged, or stolen items. Lost & found is located at the NWCSRA office.

## Inclusion Services

Northern Will County SRA understands that not every person with a disability needs to participate in special recreation programs. If you feel that a program offered by your park district/recreation department (Bolingbrook, Lockport, Plainfield, or Romeoville) would better meet the needs of your child, teen or adult; follow these steps for inclusion:

1. Register at your local park district/recreation department for the desired program as soon as possible. Let them know you will be requesting inclusion assistance.
2. Through meeting(s), observations, etc., it will be determined if inclusion in the program would be appropriate and beneficial, and if inclusion support is needed.

Please understand we do our best to provide inclusion support, however, we cannot guarantee a support staff. Register early to ensure plenty of time to secure the assistance that is needed.

## WHAT IS HEALTHY MINDS HEALTHY BODIES?

- Honorable/medical discharge – DD214
- 10% disability rating or higher assigned by the VA
- Disability rating applied for, in medical review, or under appeal
- Non-service connected injury, note from your civilian doctor, or a general endorsement from a VA counselor, VOC/PVA representative
