JOB TITLE: Inclusion Support Team Member (Summer Camp)

FSLA STATUS: Hourly, part-time non-exempt position

PAY RANGE: \$17.00-\$20.75 per hour

HOURS: Hours will be set by the Superintendent and will vary depending on the inclusion assignment. Candidates may work any shifts between the hours of 7:00am-6:00pm Monday through Friday, not to exceed 480 hours per season.

LOCATION: Bolingbrook, Plainfield, Lockport, and/or Romeoville

SUPERVISION: Responsible to the Superintendent that oversees Inclusion.

JOB SUMMARY: This position is a seasonal summer camp position. Staff are assigned to work either 1:1 or in small groups with campers who need additional support in our member agency summer camps. Candidates will be working in a team environment and advocating to include individuals in the camp activities throughout the day. Duties include but are not limited to adapting activities and experiences to meet the needs of each individual, fostering social opportunities with neurotypical peers, and behavior management. Camps are held in an outside environment in various elements.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must be at least 16 years of age.
- Experience working with individuals with special needs preferred.
- Must be able to perform the duties and responsibilities independently of others.
- Must have transportation to and from program sites.
- Certification in First Aid/CPR or the ability to maintain, preferred
- Certification in CPI or the ability to maintain, preferred
- Must support the mission, vision, and values of the agency.

COMPETENCIES:

- **Safety:** Monitor activities, adhere to safety protocols, and be prepared to respond appropriately in emergency situations.
- **Integrity:** Demonstrate honesty, transparency, and ethical behavior in all interactions.
- **Knowledge:** Ability to implement the camp schedule and activities as directed by the member agency camp staff, and willingness to learn and grow in providing inclusive opportunities for individuals with disabilities within typical recreation programs.
- **Communication:** Clearly explain instructions, provide feedback, and offer encouragement to all participants. Follow directions, ask questions, and use active listening skills with colleagues and/or supervisors.
- **Interpersonal Skills:** Appropriately interact with individuals with and without disabilities, and demonstrate empathy, patience, and the ability to motivate and encourage participants to foster an inclusive and welcoming environment.
- **Professionalism:** Maintain a positive and respectful attitude, adhere to organizational policies, and model appropriate behavior for participants and fellow team members.
- **Adaptability:** Ability to make accommodations for participants with disabilities, adjusting to their changing needs and unforeseen challenges.
- **Reliability:** Ability to be dependable, flexible, punctual, and be ready to perform job duties with commitment and follow-through.
